THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

On or about May 8, 2019, in the Northern District of Florida, the defendant,

DENNIS A. TOOMER,

knowing he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed a firearm and ammunition in and affecting interstate commerce, that is:

1. a. On or about March 26, 2002, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Agg. Fleeing/Eluding LEO, Possession of Controlled Substance, and Giving False Name to LEO;
- b. On or about March 26, 2002, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Possession of Controlled Substance;

- c. On or about March 26, 2002, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Agg. Battery on a Pregnant Woman;
- d. On or about March 26, 2002, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Agg. Battery on a Pregnant Woman;
- e. On or about March 26, 2002, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Sell or Deliver of Controlled Substance;
- f. On or about March 29, 2005, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Felony Battery;
- g. On or about June 9, 2008, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Resisting LEO with Violence;
- h. On or about June 13, 2013, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Felony Battery;
- i. On or about June 13, 2013, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Possess Controlled Substance;

- j. On or about June 13, 2013, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Flee/Elude a LEO; and
- k. On or about October 15, 2015, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was convicted in the State of Florida of Poss. Firearm by Conv. Felon, Poss. Controlled Substance, and Battery on LEO.

2. For each of these crimes, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** was subject to punishment by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year.

3. Thereafter, **DENNIS A. TOOMER** did knowingly possess a firearm, to wit, a Kahr .45 caliber pistol, and Remington .45 caliber ammunition.

4. This firearm and ammunition had previously been transported in interstate commerce.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(e).

CRIMINAL FORFEITURE

The allegations contained in Count One of this Indictment are hereby realleged and incorporated by reference. Because the defendant,

DENNIS A. TOOMER,

knowingly committed the violation set forth in Count One of this Indictment, any and all interest that this defendant has in the firearm and ammunition involved in this violation is vested in the United States and hereby forfeited to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1).
