The SPECIAL MAY 2024 GRAND JURY charges:

On or about May 5, 2024, at Chicago, in the Northern District of Illinois,
Eastern Division,

RAPHAEL HAMMOND,

defendant herein, knowing that he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm, namely, a loaded Ruger Model LCP, .380 caliber semiautomatic pistol, bearing serial number 380532448, which firearm had traveled in interstate commerce prior to defendant's possession of the firearm;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

The SPECIAL MAY 2024 GRAND JURY alleges:

1. Upon conviction of an offense in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g), as set forth in this Indictment, defendant shall forfeit to the United States of America any firearms and ammunition involved in and used in the offense, as provided in Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).
2. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to, a Ruger Model LCP, .380 caliber semiautomatic pistol, bearing serial number 380532448, and associated ammunition.
