The SPECIAL NOVEMBER 2025 GRAND JURY charges:

From on or about December 14, 2025, to on or about April 9, 2026, at Chicago,
in the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, and elsewhere,

ALEXANDER MARTINEZ-QUIROZ,

defendant herein, knowing that he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce, a firearm, namely, a Great Lakes Firearms & Ammunition LLC GL-15 multi-caliber rifle, bearing serial number 4.2550, and a Glock Model 19 9mm pistol, bearing serial number BFKF135, which firearm had traveled in interstate and foreign commerce prior to defendant's possession of the firearm;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATIONS

The SPECIAL NOVEMBER 2025 GRAND JURY further alleges:

1. Upon conviction of an offense in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), as set forth in this Indictment, defendant shall forfeit to the United States of America any firearms and ammunition involved in and used in the offense, as provided in Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).

2. The property to be forfeited includes a Great Lakes Firearms & Ammunition LLC GL-15 multi-caliber rifle, bearing serial number 4.2550, and a Glock Model 19 9mm pistol, bearing serial number BFKF135, and associated magazines and ammunition.
