The SPECIAL MAY 2019 GRAND JURY charges:

MAGISTRATE JUDGE VALDEZ

On or about May 8, 2020, at Chicago, in the Northern District of Illinois,
Eastern Division,

CARLTON HARRIS,

defendant herein, knowing that he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm, namely, a loaded HK USP 9 millimeter handgun, bearing serial number 24-080925, which firearm had traveled in interstate and foreign commerce prior to defendant's possession of the firearm;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

The SPECIAL MAY 2019 GRAND JURY further alleges:

1. Upon conviction of an offense in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g), as set forth in the Indictment, defendant shall forfeit to the United States of America any firearm, magazine, and ammunition involved in and used in any offense, as provided in Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).

2. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to, a HK USP 9 millimeter handgun, bearing serial number 24-080925, magazine, and associated ammunition.
