COUNT ONE

The SPECIAL APRIL 2021 GRAND JURY charges:

On or about September 24, 2019, at Chicago, in the Northern District of
Illinois, Eastern Division,

JUAN AGUILAR,

defendant herein, maliciously damaged and destroyed, by means of fire and explosive
materials, the building located at 1659 W. Cullerton Street, Chicago, Illinois, used in
interstate commerce;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 844(i).

COUNT TWO

The SPECIAL APRIL 2021 GRAND JURY further charges:

On or about September 24, 2019, at Chicago, in the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division,

JUAN AGUILAR,

defendant herein, knowing that he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm, namely an improvised incendiary bomb, commonly known as a Molotov cocktail, and a component of an improvised incendiary bomb, a destructive device as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 921(a)(4), which destructive device had traveled in interstate commerce prior to defendant's possession of the firearm;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).
