INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT ONE

(False Statement During Purchase of a Firearm)

On or about September 14, 2016, in Monongalia County, in the Northern District of West Virginia, the defendant, **CHEYANN HAMMONDS**, in connection with the acquisition of a firearm, that is, a Glock pistol, model 17 Gen 4, 9mm caliber, serial number BBDV937, from a licensed dealer of firearms within the meaning of Title 18, United States Code, Chapter 44, knowingly made a false and fictitious written statement, which was intended and likely to deceive the licensed firearms dealer, as to a fact material to the lawfulness of such sale of the firearm to the defendant, in that the defendant falsely represented that she was the “actual transferee/buyer” of the Glock pistol and that she was not “an unlawful user of, or addicted to, marijuana”; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(a)(6) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT TWO

(False Statement During Purchase of a Firearm)

On or about September 14, 2016, in Monongalia County, in the Northern District of West Virginia, the defendant, **CHEYANN HAMMONDS**, in connection with the acquisition of a firearm, that is, a Glock pistol, model 19 Gen 4, 9mm caliber, serial number BCKH082, from a licensed dealer of firearms within the meaning of Title 18, United States Code, Chapter 44, knowingly made a false and fictitious written statement, which was intended and likely to deceive the licensed firearms dealer, as to a fact material to the lawfulness of such sale of the firearm to the defendant, in that the defendant falsely represented that she was the “actual transferee/buyer” of the Glock pistol and that she was not “an unlawful user of, or addicted to, marijuana”; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(a)(6) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT THREE

(Unlawful Possession of Firearm as Drug User)

On or about September 14, 2016, in Monongalia County, in the Northern District of West Virginia, the defendant, **CHEYANN HAMMONDS**, knowing that she was an unlawful user of and addicted to a controlled substance, that is marijuana, knowingly possessed a firearm, to wit, a Glock pistol, model 19 Gen 4, 9mm caliber, serial number BCKH082, and the firearm was in and affecting commerce; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(3) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT FOUR

(False Statement During Purchase of a Firearm)

On or about October 5, 2016, in Monongalia County, in the Northern District of West Virginia, the defendant, **CHEYANN HAMMONDS**, in connection with the acquisition of a firearm, that is, a Springfield pistol, model XDm-9, 9mm caliber, serial number MG451619, from a licensed dealer of firearms within the meaning of Title 18, United States Code, Chapter 44, knowingly made a false and fictitious written statement, which was intended and likely to deceive the licensed firearms dealer, as to a fact material to the lawfulness of such sale of the firearm to the defendant, in that the defendant falsely represented that she was the “actual transferee/buyer” of the Springfield pistol and that she was not “an unlawful user of, or addicted to, marijuana”; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(a)(6) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT FIVE

(False Statement During Purchase of a Firearm)

On or about October 5, 2016, in Marion County, in the Northern District of West Virginia, the defendant, **CHEYANN HAMMONDS**, in connection with the acquisition of a firearm, that is, a Springfield pistol, model XD-9 Tactical, 9mm caliber, serial number GM821886, from a licensed dealer of firearms within the meaning of Title 18, United States Code, Chapter 44, knowingly made a false and fictitious written statement, which was intended and likely to deceive the licensed firearms dealer, as to a fact material to the lawfulness of such sale of the firearm to the defendant, in that the defendant falsely represented that she was the “actual transferee/buyer” of the Springfield pistol and that she was not “an unlawful user of, or addicted to, marijuana”; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(a)(6) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT SIX

(Unlawful Possession of Firearm as Drug User)

On or about October 5, 2016, in Marion County, in the Northern District of West Virginia, the defendant, **CHEYANN HAMMONDS**, knowing that she was an unlawful user of and addicted to a controlled substance, that is marijuana, knowingly possessed a firearm, to wit, a Springfield pistol, model XD-9 Tactical, 9mm caliber, serial number GM821886, and the firearm was in and affecting commerce; in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(3) and 924(a)(2).
