The enclosed information is provided by the United States Department of Justice Victim Notification System (VNS). As a victim witness professional, my role is to assist you with information and services during the prosecution of this case. I am contacting you because you were identified by law enforcement as a victim or potential victim during the investigation of the above criminal case.

The indictment alleges the defendant Brian Castillo and others knowingly combined, conspired, and agreed with each other to execute a scheme and artifice to defraud and obtain money in the custody or control of various financial institutions by false and: fraudulent pretenses. On or about January 3, 2023, and continuing to July 30, 2024, in the District of Nebraska and elsewhere, defendant Castillo and co-conspirators fraudulently obtained checks from theft or receipt of stolen mail matter. The defendant would then create a counterfeit fraudulent check and alter the original payee and or the amount of the check and replace it with names and identities of individuals whose banking account information other co-conspirators had access to.

Based on an investigation conducted by the United States Postal Inspection Service, you have been identified as a victim or potential victim of the above matter.

If you have experienced financial loss due to the defendant's crime. We recommend contacting your bank or financial institution to report or dispute any fraudulent checks or charges to your account. We cannot promise any repayment of your loss; however, your loss is very important to us.

If you wish to request restitution for unreimbursed financial losses, (that has not been reimbursed or covered by your bank or financial institution), please mail your request with supporting documentation to the U.S. Attorney's Office, District of Nebraska, by **November 14, 2025**. Do **not** send requests to the Postal Inspection Service office address that is on the envelope or staple your documents. Mail all materials to the address below.

Due to the large number of victims associated with this case this letter/ notice to you is the only written notice that will be provided, as it would be impracticable to mail all notifications via postage. Reminder: Please contact our office prior to appearing for this proceeding. It is not uncommon for the court schedule to change before we can notify you of the change in a timely manner. Your contact may save you an unnecessary trip to court. Email notification is a way to eliminate the delay in time of waiting for regular mail service. Through the Victim Notification System (VNS) we will continue to provide you with updated scheduling and event information as the case proceeds through the criminal justice system. For many VNS registrants email will provide the most timely notification. VNS does not currently have an email address for you. By entering your email as part of the VNS registration process future notifications will be delivered by email, except in rare circumstances when you might also receive a letter from VNS. In order to continue to receive notifications, it is your responsibility to keep your contact information current.

You will use your Victim Identification Number (VIN) and Personal Identification Number (PIN) anytime you contact the Call Center and the first time you log into VNS on the website. If you are receiving notifications with multiple victim ID/PIN codes please contact the VNS Call Center. In addition, the first time you access the VNS website, you will be prompted to enter your last name (or business name) as currently contained in VNS. The name you should enter is
