INITIAL INFORMATION

UNITED STATES v. MILLER, TITUS

Titus Miller, a 26-year-old white male who was employed at Playful Painters Child Care from 2016 until October 2019, allegedly sexually assaulted and covertly produced sexually graphic videos and photographs of his victims.

The US Attorney's Office, District of NE has filed a criminal complaint on Titus Miller, alleging charges for Production of Child Pornography and Distribution of Child Pornography. The Defendant, Titus Miller, is scheduled for an initial appearance on November 13th, 2019 at 3:30 P.M. in courtroom #2 at the Robert V. Denney Federal Building, 100 Centennial Mall North, Lincoln, NE. If and when criminal charges related to the Sexual Assault of a Child are filed, those charges will be filed on the State level by the Lancaster County Attorney's Office.

The FBI requests that if you have information about the ongoing investigation or believe your child or other children may have been victimized by Titus Miller please e-mail the following information to Lincoln@fbi.gov:

- Parent/guardian contact information
- Child(ren)'s name and date of birth
- Dates child(ren) attended Playful Painters Child Care
- Attach two photographs of child(ren) who attended Playful Painters Child Care

There are several ways for victim families to access information as the case proceeds through the Federal Court System:

1. Case information that can be shared from the United States Attorney's Office will be posted to this website (include website address). The information shared in regards to US v. Titus Miller, must be public record before being posted on this website.
2. You are able to receive email notice of public court hearings by requesting to be entered into the Federal Victim Notification System (VNS). This system is designed to provide court notice to victims of federal crimes. To be entered into the VNS System, contact Jose Palacios, Victim Assistance Specialist at 402-661-3742. You will need to provide your email address and how you are connected to this case. Please note that not all information provided in the VNS notices will apply unless you are directly associated with the actual charges filed. However, due to the nature of this case, VNS is a system process to send out public information. Therefore, we are opening up the VNS process to all families impacted by the criminal actions.
3. Individuals may also access this public record information through PACER. PACER stands for "Public Access to Court Electronic Records", it is an electronic public access service that allows users to obtain case and docket information online from federal appellate, district, and bankruptcy courts. Those wishing to follow the case more closely through what is public record have the option to do so by signing up for a PACER account.

This is a service provided by the Federal Judiciary in keeping with its commitment to providing public access to court information via a centralized service. As a reminder, PACER is mandated by Congress and a program that is funded entirely through user fees set by the Judicial Conference.
