The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey (PA) advises that due to an upper level structural steel deck rehabilitation project at the George Washington Bridge, in both directions, only one lane will be open on the upper level during overnight and early morning hours. Construction began Monday, August 5<sup>th</sup> in the westbound direction during Week 1 and has shifted in each direction for Weeks 2 through 4. For Week 5, work will be in the eastbound direction. Directions of work will change according to the following schedule –

Week 5 – Tues, September 3, through Thurs, September 5, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. (next morning), Fri, September 6, 10 p.m. – 10 a.m. (next morning) EASTBOUND

Week 6 – Mon, September 9, through Thurs, September 12, 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. (next morning), and Fri. September 13, 10 p.m. – 10 a.m. (next morning) WESTBOUND

Also, there may be sporadic temporary holds of traffic as heavy equipment is moved in and out of the work areas. In addition to the upper level, it may be necessary to close associated ramps that lead to the upper level.

For the week of September 3rd, the lane closure schedule is as follows -

• Tues, September 3, through Thursday, September 5, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. the next morning, and Friday, September 6, 10 p.m. until 10 a.m. the next morning, <u>eastbound</u> upper level, two to three left lanes closed to NJ Tower (one lane open).

All lanes of the New York-bound lower level will be open and cash toll lanes will be staffed. Passenger vehicles should avoid heavily traveled truck routes around the bridge, use the lower level to minimize delays OR consider seeking an alternate route.
