INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

From at least in or about March 2019 through in or about August 2020, in Atlantic County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, defendant

JOSE GONZALEZ

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with others to distribute and to possess with intent to distribute 5 kilograms or more of a mixture and substance containing a detectible amount of cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

FORFEITURE ALLEGATIONS

1. The allegations set forth above are incorporated by reference as though set forth in full herein for the purpose of alleging forfeitures pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853; Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1); and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).

2. Upon conviction of the offense in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846, alleged in this Information, defendant

JOSE GONZALEZ

shall forfeit to the United States any property constituting, or derived from, any proceeds the person obtained, directly or indirectly, as a result of the commission of an offense in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846; and any property, including any firearms and ammunition, involved in or used, or intended to be used, to commit or to facilitate the commission of those offenses, including but not limited to the following:

- a. a SCCY 9mm handgun, Model CPX-1, serial number 555500, with two magazines seized on August 17, 2020
- b. \$120,900 in United States currency seized on August 17, 2020

c. Dodge Ram 3500 pickup truck, silver in color, VIN
