The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

On or about March 12, 2024, in Essex County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

DONOVAN ELLIOT,

did knowingly and intentionally distribute and possess with intent to distribute a quantity of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, and fentanyl, a Schedule II controlled substance, and a quantity of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

Upon conviction of the offense in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C) charged in this Information, the defendant,

DONOVAN ELLIOT,

shall forfeit to the United States, in accordance with Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, all right, title, and interest in any and all property constituting or derived from any proceeds the defendant obtained directly or indirectly as a result of such offense; and any and all property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit and to facilitate the commission of such offense; and all property traceable to such property.

SUBSTITUTE ASSETS PROVISION

If any of the above-described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or

omission of the defendant:

a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;

b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;

c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;

d) has been substantially diminished in value; or

e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be

subdivided without difficulty,

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section

853(p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the

forfeitable property described above.
