SUPERSEDING INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury in and for the District of New Jersey, sitting at Newark,
charges as follows:

COUNT 1

(Conspiracy to Distribute and Possess with Intent to Distribute Cocaine)

In or around January 2022, in Union County, in the District of New Jersey,
and elsewhere, the defendant,

SAMUEL ALECTUS,
a/k/a "Capet,"

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with others to distribute and
possess with intent to distribute 5 kilograms or more of a mixture or substance
containing a detectable amount of cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance,
contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

COUNT 2

(Possession with Intent to Distribute Cocaine)

On or about January 27, 2022, in Union County, in the District of New Jersey,
and elsewhere, the defendant,

SAMUEL ALECTUS,
a/k/a "Capet,"

did knowingly and intentionally possess with intent to distribute 5 kilograms or more
of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, a Schedule II
controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A)

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

Upon conviction of the offenses in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846 and Title United States Code Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A), as charged in this Superseding Indictment, the defendant,

SAMUEL ALECTUS,
a/k/a "Capet,"

shall forfeit to the United States of America, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any and all property constituting or derived from any proceeds obtained directly or indirectly as a result of the said offenses, and any and all property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit and to facilitate the commission of the offenses alleged in this Superseding Indictment.

Substitute Assets Provision

If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

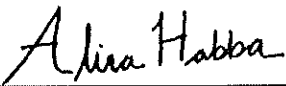
- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty,

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), as incorporated by Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), to seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the above forfeitable property.

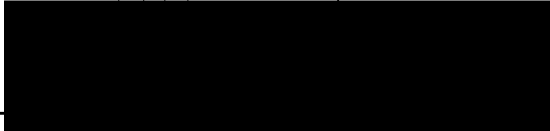
