INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey, sitting at Newark, charges:

In or around December 2014, in Warren County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

VIONEL RONDON CORTORREAL,

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with others to distribute and possess with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing one kilogram or more of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

1. As a result of committing the controlled substance offense alleged in this Information, defendant,


VIONEL RONDON CORTORREAL,

shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853, any and all property constituting or derived from any proceeds obtained directly or indirectly as a result of the said offense and any and all property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit and to facilitate the commission of the offense alleged in this Information.

2. If any of the above-described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- (a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- (c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- (d) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

the United States shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(p).
