INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury in and for the District of New Jersey, sitting at
Newark, charges:

From in or around August 2015 through in or around November
2015, in Middlesex County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere,
defendant

LUIS CALDERON,
a/k/a "Lagrima"

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with others to distribute
and to possess with intent to distribute: (i) 50 grams or more of
methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, and salts of its isomers, a Schedule II
controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections
841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A); (ii) a quantity of a mixture and substance containing
a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, contrary to
Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C); and (iii) a
quantity of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of

cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

1. The allegations contained in Count One of this Indictment are hereby realleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of noticing forfeiture pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853.

2. Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, upon conviction of violating Title 21, United States Code, Section 846, as charged in Count One, defendant

LUIS CALDERON,
a/k/a "Lagrima"


shall forfeit to the United States of America any and all property constituting or derived from any proceeds the defendant obtained, directly or indirectly, as the result of such violation, and any and all property used, or intended to be used, in any manner or part to commit and to facilitate the commission of such violation.

3. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty,

the United States of America shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p).
