SUPERSEDING INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

From in or about October 2016 through on or about June 13, 2017, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

MARK CAMPBELL,
a.k.a. "D" and "Diz,"

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with John Gunther, a.k.a. "Crittty," Taleaf Gunther, a.k.a. "Leafy" and "L," William Roland, a.k.a. "Chill," Karim Johnson, a.k.a. "Chicky," George Williams, Daron Suiter, a.k.a. "Suiter," Latoya Whealton, a.k.a. "Toya," Malcolm McCoy, Rajai Gaines, a.k.a. "Jigga," and with others, known and unknown, to distribute and to possess with intent to distribute 280 grams or more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack cocaine"), a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.
