INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT 1

From in or about June 2019 through on or about March 10, 2020, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

ROCCO DEPODER

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with others to distribute and possess with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of oxycodone, a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

COUNT 2

On or about February 3, 2020, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

ROCCO DEPODER

did knowingly and intentionally distribute and possess with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of oxycodone, a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

COUNT 3

From in or about June 2019 through on or about March 10, 2020, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

ROCCO DEPODER

did knowingly use, transfer, acquire, and possess Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program ("SNAP") benefits having a value of \$5,000 and more in a manner contrary to the provisions of Title 7, United States Code, Chapter 61 and the regulations issued pursuant thereto, that is, the defendant knowingly and unlawfully acquired SNAP benefits in exchange for distributing controlled substances, and unlawfully used and possessed those and other SNAP benefits valued, in total, in the amount of at least \$8,374.42.

In violation of Title 7, United States Code, Section 2024(b).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION AS TO COUNTS 1 & 2

As a result of committing the controlled substance offenses in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846, and Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C), as charged in Counts 1 and 2 of this Information, defendant

ROCCO DEPODER

shall forfeit to the United States of America, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any and all property constituting or derived from any proceeds obtained, directly or indirectly, as a result of the said offenses, and any and all property used, or intended to be used, in any manner or part, to commit and to facilitate the commission of the offense alleged in Counts 1 & 2 of this Information, including:

- (1) one Galaxy S9 Cell Phone, bearing IMEI 355419091933856;
- (2) one LG Cell Phone, Model LML211BL, bearing IMEI 35659393093286676;
- (3) one Samsung Galaxy Note 8, bearing IMEI 358071080858078,
- (4) one Samsung Cell Phone, bearing IMEI 358645100449024;
- (5) one Google Cell Phone, model G-ZPW2100-021A;
- (6) one iPhone, bearing IMEI 359234065242168;
- (7) one Gloucester City Police Department badge; and
- (8) \$6,598 in U.S. Currency.

SUBSTITUTE ASSETS PROVISION

If any of the above-described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant ROCCO DEPODER:

- (1) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (2) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- (3) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
- (4) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (5) has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of defendant ROCCO DEPODER up to the value of the forfeitable property described in this forfeiture allegation.
