INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury in and for the District of New Jersey, sitting at Newark, charges as follows:

COUNT 1

(Conspiracy to Distribute Oxycodone)

From in or about January 2020 through on or about March 10, 2020, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

MAURICE WILLIAMS

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with others to distribute and possess with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of oxycodone, a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

COUNT 2

(Distribution of and Possession with Intent to Distribute Oxycodone, and Attempt So to Do)

On or about February 18, 2020, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

MAURICE WILLIAMS

did knowingly and intentionally distribute and possess with intent to distribute, and attempt so to do, a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of oxycodone, a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1), 841(b)(1)(C), and 846, and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

COUNTS 3-5

(Use of a Communication Facility to Further a Drug Trafficking Crime)

On or about the dates set forth below, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

MAURICE WILLIAMS

did knowingly and intentionally use a communications facility, that is a telephone, to facilitate a conspiracy and agreement with others to distribute and possess with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of oxycodone, a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C), which acts are prohibited by the provisions of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846, as listed below:

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 843(b).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

As a result of committing one or more of the controlled substance offenses in violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(C), 843(b), and 846, as charged in Counts 1 - 5 of this Indictment, the defendant

MAURICE WILLIAMS

shall forfeit to the United States of America, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853, any and all property constituting and derived from any proceeds the defendant obtained directly and indirectly as a result of the said offenses, and any and all property used and intended to be used in any manner and part to commit and to facilitate the commission of one and more of the offenses alleged in this Indictment.

SUBSTITUTE ASSETS PROVISION

If any of the above-described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- (a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- (c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
- (d) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;
