INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the Acting United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

COUNT ONE

(Illegal Possession of a Machinegun)

On or about August 31, 2020, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

CHRISTIAN CORDERO-GOTAY,

did knowingly possess a machinegun, namely a 9mm, privately made Glock-type semiautomatic handgun, bearing no serial number, equipped with a Glock conversion device, commonly referred to as a “Glock switch,” as defined in Title 26, United States Code, Section 5845(b).

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(o).

COUNT TWO

(Possession of an Unregistered Firearm)

On or about August 31, 2020, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere,
the defendant,

CHRISTIAN CORDERO-GOTAY,

did knowingly possess a machinegun, namely a 9mm privately made Glock-type semiautomatic handgun, bearing no serial number, equipped with a Glock conversion device, commonly referred to as a "Glock switch," as defined in Title 26, United States Code, Section 5845(b), which was not registered to him in the National Firearms Registration and Transfer Record.

In violation of Title 26, United States Code, Section 5861(d).

COUNT THREE

(Possession of Ammunition by a Convicted Felon)

On or about August 31, 2020, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere,
the defendant,

CHRISTIAN CORDERO-GOTAY,

knowing that he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, did knowingly possess in and affecting interstate commerce eighteen (18) rounds of 9mm ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

Upon conviction of the offenses set forth in this Information, the defendant,

CHRISTIAN CORDERO-GOTAY,

shall forfeit to the United States of America, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 924(d)(1) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), any firearm and ammunition involved in or used in the commission of such offenses, including, but not limited to, the following:


- (1) one 9mm, privately made Glock-type semiautomatic handgun, bearing no serial number, equipped with a Glock conversion device, commonly referred to as a "Glock switch;" and
- (2) eighteen (18) rounds of 9mm ammunition.

SUBSTITUTE ASSETS PROVISION

If any of the above described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- (a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- (c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- (d) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty,

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the above described forfeitable property.
