INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury in and for the District of New Jersey, sitting at Newark, charges:

COUNT ONE
(Bank Robbery)

On or about April 7, 2021, in Bergen County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

SENECA WILSON,

did, by force, violence, and intimidation, knowingly take from the person and presence of another, namely, employees of Victim Bank-1 located in Rutherford, New Jersey, approximately \$2,300 in money belonging to, and in the care, custody, control, management, and possession of Victim Bank-1, a bank whose deposits were then insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

1. As the result of committing the offense of bank robbery in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a) set forth in this Indictment, the defendant,

SENECA WILSON,

shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 981(a)(1)(C) and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), all property, real and personal, that constitutes or is derived from proceeds traceable to the commission of the said offense, and all property traceable thereto, including but not limited to a sum of money equal to \$2,300 in United States Currency, representing the proceeds of the offense charged in this Indictment.

SUBSTITUTE ASSETS PROVISION

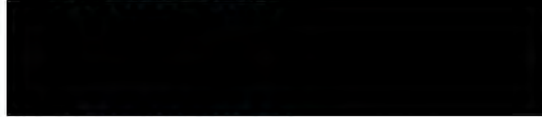
If any of the above described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- (a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- (c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- (d) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;


it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code,

Section 853(p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the above described forfeitable property.
