I N F O R M A T I O N

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment,  
the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

**COUNT ONE**  
**(Receipt of Child Pornography)**

On or about June 18, 2017, in Ocean County, in the District of New  
Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

DAVID M. FREW,

did knowingly receive child pornography, as defined in Title 18, United States  
Code, Section 2256(8), that had been mailed, and using any means and facility  
of interstate and foreign commerce, shipped, and transported in and affecting  
interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252A(a)(2)(A) and  
2252A(b)(1).

**COUNT TWO**  
**(Online Enticement of a Minor to Engage in Criminal Sexual Conduct)**

From on or about May 21, 2017, through on or about June 29, 2017, in Ocean County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

DAVID M. FREW,

using the mail and any facility and means of interstate and foreign commerce, did knowingly persuade, induce, entice, and coerce, and attempt to persuade, induce, entice, and coerce, MINOR VICTIM 1, an individual who had not attained the age of 18 years, to engage in sexual activity for which any person could be charged with a criminal offense.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2422(b).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

1. The allegations above and on pages 1 and 2 of this Information hereby are realleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253(a).

2. Upon conviction of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2422(b) and 2252A(a)(2)(A) charged in this Information, the defendant,

DAVID M. FREW,

shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253,

- a. any visual depiction described in 18 U.S.C. §§ 2251, 2251A, 2252, 2252A, 2252B, or 2260, or any book, magazine, periodical, film, videotape, or other matter which contains any such visual depiction, which was produced, transported, mailed, shipped or received in violation of 18 U.S.C. Part I, Chapter 110;
- b. any property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from the offenses charged in this Information, and all property traceable to such property; and
- c. any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of such offenses, and all property traceable to such property.

3. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to, all of the defendant's right, title, and interest in the following items:

- a. an iPhone 4s cellular telephone, bearing serial number C8PL815YDTF9;

- b. an iPhone 7 cellular telephone, bearing serial number  
F73SJPAPHG6W;
  - c. an iPad Air tablet computer, bearing serial number  
DMPQN2ECFK10; and
  - d. an HP Envy M6 personal computer, bearing serial number  
CND25012YH.
4. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:
- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
  - b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
  - c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
  - d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
  - e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided  
without difficulty,
- the United States of America shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), as incorporated by Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253(b) and by Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c).
