I N F O R M A T I O N

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

On or about April 20, 2022, in Bergen County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

JOSE MIGEL CLETO,

did knowingly and intentionally distribute, and possess with the intent to distribute, a quantity of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl, a Schedule II controlled substance.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C) and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

1. Upon conviction of the defendant, **JOSE MIGEL CLETO**, of the offense in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C), charged in this Information, the United States will seek forfeiture, in accordance with 21 U.S.C. § 853, of all right, title, and interest of the defendant in any and all property constituting or derived from any proceeds the said defendant obtained directly or indirectly as a result of such offense(s); and any and all property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit and to facilitate the commission of such offense(s); and all property traceable to such property.

SUBSTITUTE ASSETS PROVISION

2. If any of the above-described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- (a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- (c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- (d) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of said defendant up to the value of the forfeitable property described above.
