The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by

Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges
that:

At all times relevant to this Information:

1. The Defendant CHARLES STANGO held the position as a "made" member of a criminal organization that operates in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere. As a result of this status, he had the ability, among others, to commit and sanction acts of physical violence in the name of the organization.

- 2. Beginning in or about February 14, 2015, the defendant STANGO developed a plan to punish Victim-1 for masquerading as a sanctioned "made" man in the same criminal organization; a position which STANGO believed was wrongly bestowed on Vicitm-1.
- 3. From on or about February 14, 2015 through on or about March 8 2015 in the Districts of New Jersey and Nevada, and elsewhere, the defendant,

did knowingly and willfully use an interstate facility, namely a telephone, with the intent that the murder of Victim-1 be committed, in violation of the laws of the State of New Jersey, specifically N.J.S.A. 2C:11-3, and as consideration for the receipt of, and for a promise and agreement to pay things of pecuniary value, to wit: \$50,000.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1958(a).
