The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for District of New Jersey charges:

From in or about May 2014 to on or about September 1, 2015, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

HAROLD MILLER

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with Rodney Wall, Rasheed Wise, David Wilkerson and others, known and unknown, to distribute and to possess with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base, commonly known as crack cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.
