The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

On or about January 31, 2015, in Middlesex County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, defendant

MATTHEW KAMINSKY

did knowingly receive child pornography, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(8)(A), that had been mailed, and using any means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce, shipped and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a)(2)(A).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

The United States hereby gives notice to the defendant MATTHEW KAMINSKY that, upon his conviction of the offenses charged in this Information, the Government will seek forfeiture in accordance with Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253, of (a) any visual depiction described in Section 2251, 2251A, 2252, 2252A, 2252B, or 2260 of Title 18, United States Code, or any book, magazine, periodical, film, videotape, or other matter which contains any such visual depiction, which was produced, transported, mailed, shipped or received in violation of such sections; (b) any property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from the offense of conviction; and (c) any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of the offense of conviction or any property traceable to such property, including, but not limited to:

- 1. One Dell Alienware laptop computer, bearing Serial Number
 OT5FWH, including the Western Digital Scorpio, 750 GB hard
 drive bearing Serial Number WXF2E32NFTW5 and;
- 2. One Apple iPad 3 tablet, bearing Serial Number DLXH9FUHDVGJ;
- One Apple iPad Mini tablet, bearing Serial Number
 F4KMV1BLFLMQ;
- One Samsung GT-P3113 cellular telephone, bearing Serial Number
 R32X301F7AL;

- One Apple Macbook Air laptop computer, bearing Serial Number
 WMC4MO351606;
- 6. One Samsung SM-N990T cellular telephone, bearing Serial Number RC8DCOZ84LV;
- 7. One Dell Alienware P06T laptop computer, bearing Serial Number 0YZXT6, including the Seagate Momentus, 500GB hard drive bearing Serial Number 5VJ3HJJM;
- 8. One ScanDisk Cruzer 8GB Thumb Drive;
- 9. One 1TB Toshiba External Hard Drive; and
- One blue Seagate 1TB External Hard Drive, bearing Serial Number
 NAOCEF76.

If any of the above-described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- (a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
 - (c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
 - (d) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty; it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), as incorporated by Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253(b), to seek forfeiture of any other property of such

defendant up to the value of the forfeitable property described in this forfeiture allegation.
