INFORMATION

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

(Conspiracy to Distribute and Possess with Intent to Distribute Cocaine Base)

From in or about November 2015 through on or about September 12, 2016, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

JOSEPH BOYD, a.k.a. "Breet,"

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with Jason Boyd, a.k.a. "Teddy," "Teddy Reek," and "Fatboy"; Preston J. Thomas, a.k.a. "Boo"; Tony Wilson, a.k.a. "Tony Langston," "Tone," and "H"; Derek Stallworth, a.k.a. "AK" and "A"; Jeffrey Whitaker, a.k.a. "Jay," "Jay Black," and "Black"; Nafeez Griffin, a.k.a. "Feez"; and Julian Dickerson, a.k.a. "Juelz"; and with others, known and unknown, to distribute and to possess with intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base ("crack cocaine"), a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.
