INDICTMENT


The Grand Jury charges:

Between on or about June 27, 2019 and July 1, 2019, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **MYRON BENALLY**, an Indian, knowingly and recklessly, and without justifiable cause, caused John Doe, a child under the age of 18, to be placed in a situation that may have endangered the child's life or health and to be cruelly tortured and cruelly punished, resulting in great bodily harm to John Doe.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1153 and N.M. STAT. ANN. § 30-6-1(D).
