INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

On or about May 15, 2025, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **JAY RAY KELLY**, knowing that he had been convicted of at least one crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, specifically, possession of a firearm in a school zone, knowingly possessed a firearm and ammunition in and affecting commerce.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924.

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION


Upon conviction of any offense in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g), the defendant, **JAY RAY KELLY**, shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), any firearms and ammunition involved in the commission of the offense, including, but not limited to:

- a. A .22-caliber Smith & Wesson revolver, Serial no. 232K205, with a separate black cylinder;
- b. Five rounds of .22-magnum caliber ammunition recovered from **JAY RAY KELLY**'s pink backpack on May 15, 2025; and

- c. 150 rounds of .17 HMR ammunition recovered from **JAY RAY KELLY**'s pink backpack on May 15, 2025.
