INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about October 6, 2023, in Santa Fe County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **AIMEE LAMAR**, unlawfully, knowingly, and intentionally distributed a controlled substance, and the offense involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl (N-phenyl-N-[1-(2-phenylethyl)-4-piperidinyl] propanamide), and death resulted from the use of such substance.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C), and 18 U.S.C. § 2.

Count 2

On or about October 6, 2023, in Santa Fe County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **AIMEE LAMAR**, unlawfully, knowingly, and intentionally distributed a controlled

substance, and the offense involved a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, and death resulted from the use of such substance.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(C), and 18 U.S.C. § 2.

SENTENCING ALLEGATION

Death resulted from the use of the controlled substances described in Counts 1 and 2 of the indictment.
