INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about August 1, 2025, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **BRYSON CHEE**, assaulted Jane Doe and John Doe with a dangerous weapon, specifically, a pistol, with intent to do bodily harm.

Count 2

On or about August 1, 2025, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **BRYSON CHEE**, knowingly used and carried a firearm, during and in relation to a crime of violence for which the defendant may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, specifically, assault with a dangerous weapon as charged in Count 1 of this indictment, and possessed said firearm in furtherance of such crime, and the firearm was discharged.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 924(c)(1)(A)(iii).

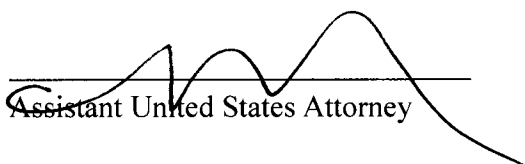
FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

Upon conviction of any offense in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 924(c), the defendant, **BRYSON CHEE**, shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), any firearms and ammunition involved in the commission of the offenses, including, but not limited to:

- a. a Smith and Wesson 9mm pistol with serial number FBH7024, and
- b. two magazines.
