INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about January 10, 2025, in Indian Country, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendants, **MYRON SCOTT** and **ERIC SCOTT**, Indians, assaulted John Doe with a dangerous weapon, specifically, a baseball bat and a log, with the intent to do bodily harm.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153, 113(a)(3), and 2.

Count 2

On or about January 10, 2025, in Indian Country, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendants, **MYRON SCOTT** and **ERIC SCOTT**, Indians, assaulted John Doe, and the assault resulted in serious bodily injury.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153, 113(a)(6), and 2.

Count 3

On or about January 10, 2025, in Indian Country, in McKinley County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **MYRON SCOTT**, an Indian, assaulted Jane Doe with a dangerous weapon, specifically, a baseball bat, with the intent to do bodily harm.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153 and 113(a)(3).
