Jason Cunningham

I, Devon Stinson, a Task Force Officer with Homeland Security Investigations (HSI), being duly sworn, state that the following information is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief:

On September 3, 2025, as Pecos Valley Drug Task Force Agents were waiting to execute a search warrant at the residence of Jason Cunningham in Carlsbad, New Mexico, agents observed Cunningham leave the residence, appearing to be in route to work. Eddy County Sheriff's Deputies performed a traffic stop on Cunningham shortly after he left his residence.

Agents then executed the New Mexico District Court search warrant at Cunningham's residence. During the search of the residence, agents located approximately 1,090 gross grams of methamphetamine and 56 gross grams of cocaine locked inside a safe in Cunningham's bedroom.

In a post-*Miranda* interview, Cunningham admitted to purchasing large quantities of methamphetamine and selling it for \$5 a gram. Cunningham also admitted to sharing methamphetamine with friends.

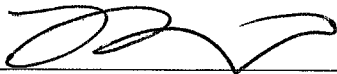
Based on my knowledge, experience, and training, and the facts set forth above, there is probable cause to believe that on September 3, 2025, Jason Cunningham possessed with intent to distribute approximately 1,090 gross grams of methamphetamine in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A).

Assistant United States Attorney Renee Camacho approved federal prosecution of Jason Cunningham.
