INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges that:

On or about October 11, 2024, in Miami-Dade County, in the Southern District of Florida, the defendant,

NICHOLAS MCINTYRE,

did knowingly possess a firearm in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce, knowing that he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(l).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATIONS

- 1. The allegations of this Indictment are hereby re-alleged and by this reference fully incorporated herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States of America of certain property in which the defendant, **NICHOLAS MCINTYRE**, has an interest.
- 2. Upon conviction of a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g) or any other criminal law of the United States, as alleged in this Indictment, the defendant shall forfeit

to the United States any firearm involved in or used in the commission of such offense, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1).
