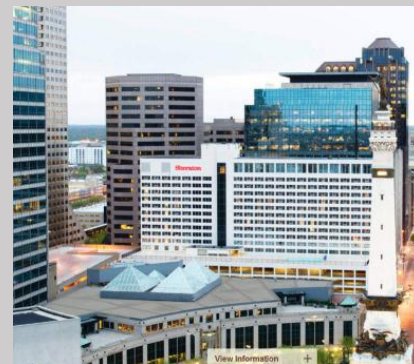

Important Information

This training is *free* to all state, county, and local law enforcement agencies. **Two nights** lodging (**9/9 & 9/10**) will be paid for state, county, or local law enforcement only (employees of the federal government or private corporations are not eligible). For lodging to be covered, the eligible attendees must live more than 50 miles from the conference location. Attendees staying more than the designated 2 night's are responsible for the extra night's expense. Those who register and *do not* attend will be responsible for the lodging expense if not cancelled by the required deadlines. Mileage and per diem will not be covered and are the responsibility of the individual or agency. **All hotel rooms will be double occupancy with ONLY conference attendees.**

Lodging will be at the Sheraton Hotel City Centre, 31 W. Ohio Street, Indianapolis, IN 46204. Once participants arrive at the hotel they will be required to provide a credit card to cover any incidentals. The credit card (no debit cards, please) will not be charged for the room fee *if* the attendee meets the eligibility requirements. **Lodging requests must be received by August 21, 2015 (The US Attorney's Office will make the reservations, cancellations and/or room assignments for preferred partners). Lodging cancellations must be made through the US Attorney's office no later than August 21, 2015.** Parking at the Sheraton Hotel will be free for attendees. Conference registration cancellations must be made by August 21, 2015 using the confirmation link.
