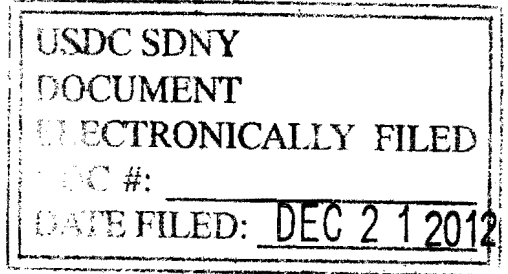

**ORDER**
