COUNT ONE
(Hate Crime Act)

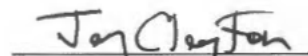
The Grand Jury charges:

1. On or about April 1, 2026, in the Southern District of New York and elsewhere, SHORAI MOORE, the defendant, willfully caused bodily injury to a victim ("Victim-1"), and through the use of a dangerous weapon attempted to cause bodily injury to Victim-1, because of Victim-1's actual and perceived sexual orientation, and, in connection with the offense, MOORE employed a dangerous weapon or other weapon that had traveled in interstate or foreign commerce, interfered with commercial or other economic activity in which Victim-1 was engaged at the time of the conduct, and otherwise affected interstate and foreign commerce, to wit, MOORE, who was serving a term of imprisonment at a Federal Bureau of Prisons residential reentry center, yelled anti-gay slurs and statements outside of a deli on White Plains Road in the Bronx, including that gay people should "get off the block," and then assaulted and attempted to assault Victim-1, who is gay, with his fist, a recycling bin, and a plastic crate.
