COUNT ONE

The Grand Jury charges:

1. On or about June 30, 2009, in the Southern District of New York, JAMAL BRISSETT, a/k/a "Trigger," the defendant, willfully and knowingly, during and in relation to a drug trafficking crime for which he may be prosecuted in a court of the United States, and during and in relation to a Hobbs Act robbery in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1951, did use and carry a firearm, and, in furtherance of such crimes, did possess a firearm, and in the course of those crimes did cause the death of a person through the use of a firearm, which killing is murder as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 1111(a), to wit, BRISSETT shot and killed Lashaun Gordon in the vicinity of Mickle Avenue and Chester

Street in the Bronx, New York.

(Title 18, United States Code, Sections 924(j)(1) and 2.)


COUNT TWO

The Grand Jury further charges:

2. On or about July 1, 2009, in the Southern District of New York, JAMAL BRISSETT, a/k/a "Trigger," the defendant, and others known and unknown, did knowingly and intentionally use fire to commit one or more felonies prosecutable in a court of the United States, to wit, BRISSETT willfully caused the burning of the car in which the murder charged in Count One occurred, and did thereby obstruct justice, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1512(c) and 1519.
