Emphasis is placed on identifying these characteristics and taking the appropriate enforcement actions leading to safe and successful crime gun recoveries while underscoring the special significance of effectively articulating, both in paperwork and testimony, the specific factors relied upon to support a successful prosecution.

Key course components include: Characteristics of Armed Gunmen; Developing Articulable Suspicion; Street-level Enforcement Activities, Consensual Encounters, Stops and Frisks; Vehicles Stops; Firearms Case Preparation; and Firearms Case Articulation and Testimony.
