INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT 1

(Unlawful Destruction, Detention, and Delay of Mail by Postal Employee)

Beginning in March 2013, and continuing to on or about March 3, 2014, in Schoolcraft County, in the Western District of Michigan, Northern Division, the defendant,

SARAH JANE PARADISE,

a U.S. Postal Service City Carrier assigned to City Route 1 in Manistique, Michigan, unlawfully destroyed, detained and delayed letters and mail which were entrusted to her and came into her possession, and which were intended to be conveyed by mail.

COUNT 2

(Unlawful Detention and Delay of Mail by Postal Employee)

On or about March 4, 2014, in Schoolcraft County, in the Western District of Michigan, Northern Division, the defendant,

SARAH JANE PARADISE,

a U.S. Postal Service City Carrier assigned to City Route 1 in Manistique, Michigan, unlawfully detained and delayed letters and mail which were entrusted to her and came into her possession, and which were intended to be conveyed by mail.


