

Instructions for using your Government Furnished Equipment (GFE) iPhone as an internet “Hotspot” for your GFE laptop or iPad.

Note: Per EOUSA Security Policy, only GFE laptops or iPads are permitted to connect to the internet via an iPhone “personal hotspot”.

1. Got to Settings on your iPhone and turn on the Wi-fi signal, either at home, a hotel or a secure public location.
2. Touch Personal Hotspot:

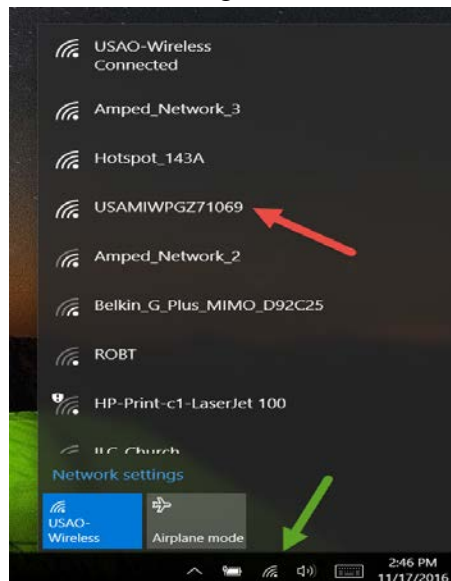


3. Turn on the Personal Hotspot sliding the “Allow Others to Join” On/Off switch to the right.
4. Make note of your Wi-Fi password, you will need this when connecting to the iPhone’s hotspot on the GFE laptop or iPad. (See image below):



GFE Laptop:

1. Power on the laptop and login with your PIV or network password.
2. Click on the wireless icon at the bottom right hand side of the screen (see the green arrow in the image below):

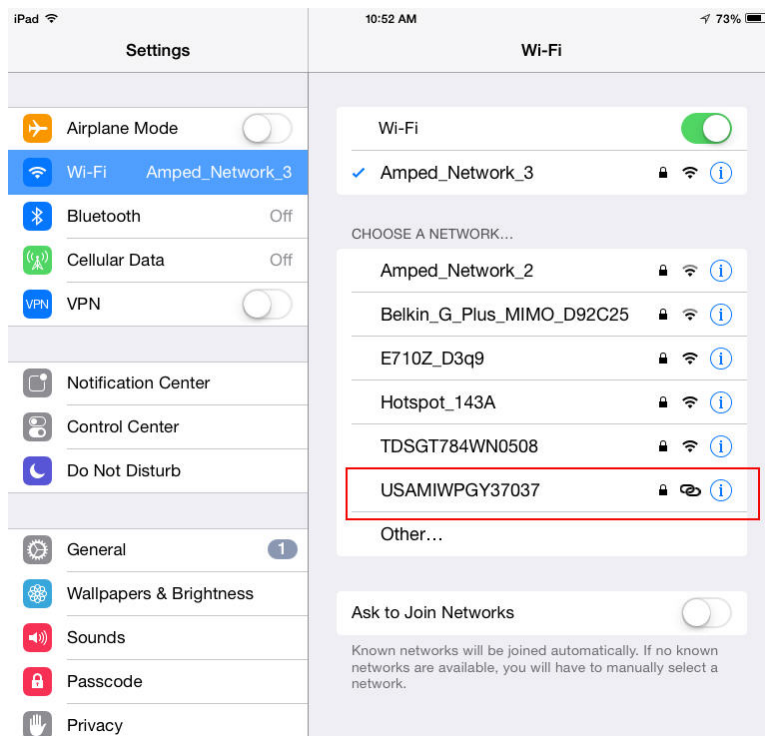


3. Choose the wireless connection for your iPhone (see the red arrow above), it should be similar to USAMIWPGZ##### and click on Connect. When prompted for the Security key, type in the Wi-Fi Password from your iPhone, (see step #4 above) and click Ok.

NOTE: This only provides your laptop with a wireless connection, to access Outlook, IE, or any government applications; you still need to complete the PIV or RSA/VPN connection procedures.

GFE iPad:

1. Power on the iPad and login with the device specific passcode.
2. Touch Settings/Wi-Fi and choose the iPhone “HotSpot”



3. When prompted for the password, type in the iPhone Wi-Fi Password, (see Step #4 above) and then touch “Join”.

NOTE: This only provides your GFE laptop or iPad with an internet connection, to access any government applications; you still need to complete the RSA/VPN connection procedures.
