
CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

I, the undersigned complainant being duly sworn, state the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief:

On or about December 20, 2016, in the Western District of Missouri, the defendants, ROY L. HOUSE, JR., AND CURLIE PRUITT, III, both having previously been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, both did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm and ammunition, to wit: a loaded American Tactical, semi-automatic handgun, .45 caliber, Model M1911GI, Serial Number G112142, all of which had been transported in interstate commerce, contrary to the provisions of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).
