**INDICTMENT**

The Grand Jury charges that:

**COUNT 1**  
**(Distribution of a Controlled Substance)**  
**(Rochester Parking Lot)**

On or about March 3, 2022, in Thurston County, within the Western District of Washington, and elsewhere, JUAN TOLENTINO-CHINO and JOSE VENEGAS-GATICA, and others known and unknown, did knowingly and intentionally distribute, and aid and abet the distribution of, a controlled substance, including: methamphetamine, a substance controlled under Title 21, United States Code.

The Grand Jury further alleges that the offense involved 50 grams or more of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of its isomers.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

**COUNT 2**  
**(Distribution of a Controlled Substance)**  
**(Hoquiam Parking Lot)**

On or about March 9, 2022, in Grays Harbor County, within the Western District of Washington, and elsewhere, JUAN TOLENTINO-CHINO and JOSE VENEGAS-GATICA, and others known and unknown, did knowingly and intentionally distribute, and aid and abet the distribution of, a controlled substance, including: methamphetamine, a substance controlled under Title 21, United States Code.

The Grand Jury further alleges that the offense involved 50 grams or more of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of its isomers.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

**COUNT 3**  
**(Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute)**  
**(Kelso Train Station)**

On or about March 31, 2022, in Cowlitz County, within the Western District of Washington, and elsewhere, ESTEBAN MARTINEZ-ORTIZ and JESUS VENEGAS-GATICA, and others known and unknown, did knowingly and intentionally possess, with the intent to distribute, and aid and abet the possession of, with the intent to distribute, a controlled substance, including: methamphetamine, a substance controlled under Title 21, United States Code.

The Grand Jury further alleges that the offense involved 500 grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of its isomers.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

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**COUNT 4**  
**(Distribution of a Controlled Substance)**  
***(Centralia Parking Lot)***

On or about April 7, 2022, in Lewis County, within the Western District of Washington, and elsewhere, CRISTOBAL VENEGAS-DIAZ and JOSE VENEGAS-GATICA, and others known and unknown, did knowingly and intentionally distribute, and aid and abet the distribution of, a controlled substance, including: methamphetamine, a substance controlled under Title 21, United States Code.

The Grand Jury further alleges that the offense involved 500 grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of its isomers.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

**COUNT 5**  
**(Distribution of a Controlled Substance)**  
***(Centralia Parking Lot)***

On or about April 21, 2022, in Lewis County, within the Western District of Washington, and elsewhere, CRISTOBAL VENEGAS-DIAZ, and others known and unknown, did knowingly and intentionally distribute, and aid and abet the distribution of, a controlled substance, including: methamphetamine, a substance controlled under Title 21, United States Code.

The Grand Jury further alleges that the offense involved 50 grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of its isomers.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(B), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

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**COUNT 6****(Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute)  
(Lakewood Residence)**

On or about May 11, 2021, in Pierce County, within the Western District of Washington, and elsewhere, JESUS VENEGAS-GATICA and others known and unknown, did knowingly and intentionally possess, with the intent to distribute, and aid and abet the possession of, with the intent to distribute, a controlled substance, including: methamphetamine, a substance controlled under Title 21, United States Code.

The Grand Jury further alleges that the offense involved 500 grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of its isomers.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

**COUNT 7****(Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute)  
(Vehicle)**

On or about May 11, 2021, in Lewis County, within the Western District of Washington, and elsewhere, CRISTOBAL VENEGAS-DIAZ and others known and unknown, did knowingly and intentionally possess, with the intent to distribute, and aid and abet the possession of, with the intent to distribute, a controlled substance, including: methamphetamine, a substance controlled under Title 21, United States Code.

The Grand Jury further alleges that the offense involved 500 grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of methamphetamine, its salts, isomers, or salts of its isomers.

All in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(A), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 2.

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**FORFEITURE ALLEGATION**

The allegations contained in Counts 1-7 of this Indictment are hereby realleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture.

**COUNTS 1 and 2**  
**(Distribution of Controlled Substances)**

Upon conviction of either of the offenses alleged in Counts 1 and 2, JUAN TOLENTINO-CHINO and JOSE VENEGAS-GATICA shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any property that constitutes or is traceable to proceeds of the offense, as well as any property that facilitated the offense. This property includes, but is not limited to a sum of money reflecting the proceeds the relevant defendant obtained from the offense.

**COUNT 3**  
**(Possession with Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine)**

Upon conviction of the offense alleged in Count 3, ESTEBAN MARTINEZ-ORTIZ and JESUS VENEGAS-GATICA shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any property that constitutes or is traceable to proceeds of the offense, as well as any property that facilitated the offense.

**COUNT 4**  
**(Distribution of Controlled Substances)**

Upon conviction of the offense alleged in Count 4, CRISTOBAL VENEGAS-DIAZ and JOSE VENEGAS-GATICA shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any property that constitutes or is traceable to proceeds of the offense, as well as any property that facilitated the offense. This property includes, but is not limited to a sum of money reflecting the proceeds the relevant defendant obtained from the offense.

**COUNT 5**

**(Distribution of Controlled Substances)**

Upon conviction of the offense alleged in Count 5, CRISTOBAL VENEGAS-DIAZ shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any property that constitutes or is traceable to proceeds of the offense, as well as any property that facilitated the offense. This property includes, but is not limited to a sum of money reflecting the proceeds CRISTOBAL VENEGAS-DIAZ obtained from the offense.

**COUNT 6**

**(Possession with Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine)**

Upon conviction of the offense alleged in Count 6, JESUS VENEGAS-GATICA shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any property that constitutes or is traceable to proceeds of the offense, as well as any property that facilitated the offense.

**COUNT 7**

**(Possession with Intent to Distribute Methamphetamine)**

Upon conviction of the offense alleged in Count 7, CRISTOBAL VENEGAS-DIAZ shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any property that constitutes or is traceable to proceeds of the offense, as well as any property that facilitated the offense.

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1 **Substitute Assets.** If any of the above-described forfeitable property, as a result of any  
2 act or omission of the defendant,

- 3 a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;  
4 b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;  
5 c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;  
6 d. has been substantially diminished in value; or,  
7 e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided  
8 without difficulty,


9 it is the intent of the United States to seek the forfeiture of any other property of the  
10 defendant, up to the value of the above-described forfeitable property, pursuant to  
11 Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p).
