

## INFORMATION

The United States Attorney charges:

#### INTRODUCTORY ALLEGATIONS

20 | At all times relevant to this Information:

- 1. Defendant BRIANA IRENE ROY was employed as a marketing communications specialist in the Medical Marketing Division at A&D Engineering ("A&D"), located in San Jose, California.
  - 2. E.S. was a director-level employee with A&D until on or about September 2012.
- 3. E.S. had one or more VISA bank cards issued to him through the A&D finance department to be used for his official duties on behalf of A&D, the bills for which would be and were paid directly by A&D.
- 4. PayPal is an international e-commerce business which allows payments and money transfers to be made via the Internet, and is a wholly owned subsidiary of eBay, Inc. Paypal is headquartered in San

Jose, California. 1 5. PayPal's Credit Card processing system is run through Wells Fargo Bank in Minneapolis, 2 3 Minnesota. COUNT ONE: 18 U.S.C. § 1343 (Wire Fraud) 4 6. Paragraphs 1 through 5 are re-alleged and incorporated as if fully set forth here. 5 SCHEME AND ARTIFICE TO DEFRAUD 6 7. Beginning in or about May 2010 and continuing through at least January 2013, in the Northern 7 District of California, 8 BRIANA IRENE ROY, 9 did knowingly devise and intend to devise, and participate in, a material scheme and artifice to defraud 10 A&D, and to obtain money and property from A&D by means of materially false and fraudulent 11 pretenses, representations, promises, and omissions, by improperly using or fraudulently charging one or 12 more VISA credit cards issued in the name of A&D employee, E.S., which were only to be used to make 13 purchases authorized by and for the benefit of A&D, when in truth and fact the defendant was not 14 authorized to charge these cards and was not providing any products or services in exchange for the 15 money. 16 USE OF WIRES 17 8. On or about December 12, 2012, in the Northern District of California, for the purpose of 18 executing the aforementioned scheme and artifice to defraud, the defendant, 19 BRIANA IRENE ROY, 20 did knowingly transmit and cause to be transmitted by means of wire communications in interstate 21 commerce \$ 4833.53, from a U.S. Bank VISA card, issued in the name of E.S. to a PayPal account in 22 the defendant's name and controlled by the defendant. 23 24 //// 25 26 27 28
