ONE “EVANS FAMILY” MEMBER SENTENCED AS PART OF INTERSTATE PROSTITUTION RING

St. Louis, MO - A member of the so-called “Evans Family” from Minneapolis, Minnesota, was sentenced in U.S. District Court in St. Louis after having been convicted by a federal jury of charges involving an interstate prostitution ring.

Clem Evans was sentenced to 240 months in federal prison based on his conviction for conspiracy to transport women in interstate commerce for the purpose of prostitution and money laundering.
