ATTACHMENT "A" TO THE CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

On December 10, 2010, agents from the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the Chaves County Metro Narcotics Task Force (CCMNTF) executed a State of New Mexico District Court Search Warrant at the residence of William Cadman in Roswell, NM. During the search, agents found approximately 4.9 gross grams of methamphetamine (meth) located in a center pocket of the pool table that was positioned in the dining room of the residence. Also, located throughout the residence were various items consistent with narcotics trafficking and distribution operation. These items included, but were not limited to, packaging materials, a digital scale, and several surveillance cameras.

Found in a corner pocket of the pool table where the meth was located, was a Taurus Millenium Model, S/N TSG27050, 9mm handgun, which was loaded with one round of ammunition in the chamber and four rounds of ammunition in the magazine. On top of the pool table, secreted under a wooden cover, the following weapons were recovered: a Ruger Ranch Rifle, S/N 187-43066, .223 caliber, loaded with a magazine containing ammunition, a Superior Arms S-15, S/N 001066, 5.56mm rifle, loaded with a magazine containing ammunition, and a Kahr Arms, Thompson Semi-automatic Carbine, Model of 1927-A1, S/N KA2333, .45 ACP, which was not loaded.

Checks with the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco Firearms and Explosives, ATF, show that the above described firearms, which were manufactured respectively by Taurus International Manufacturing Inc., Sturm, Ruger, and Co. Inc., Superior Arms Inc., and Kahr Arms, are not and have never been manufactured in New Mexico. Additionally, there are no manufacturers of firearms or ammunition in the state of New Mexico. Therefore, the firearms and ammunition possessed by Cadman on December 10, 2010, had previously traveled in and affected interstate commerce.

On or about October 5, 2005, Cadman was arrested and charged with one felony count of possession of methamphetamine and one felony count of distribution of methamphetamine. Cadman was found guilty on both counts and was sentenced to four years incarceration by the Chaves County 5th Judicial Court. Most recently, on or about May 6, 2009, Cadman was charged with and found guilty of felony possession of a controlled substance.

Also on December 10, 2010, agents executed a State of New Mexico District Court Search Warrant on a vehicle registered to Cadman and one that he had been driving on this date. During this search, agents found a total of approximately 131.3 gross grams of meth located in the passenger area of the truck. A torn plastic baggie containing approximately 55.5 gross grams of meth was found beneath the passenger seat on the floor board of the truck. A second plastic baggie containing approximately 75.8 gross grams of meth was found secreted inside of the side panel of the truck directly behind the driver's seat.

Following the search, the meth that was found at Cadman's residence and in his vehicle field tested positive for the presence of methamphetamine.
