## Attachment A

I, Christopher Godier, a Special Agent of the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), being duly sworn, depose and state:

I am a Special Agent of the Drug Enforcement Administration and have been so employed since August 2003. I am currently assigned to the Albuquerque District Office, of the DEA, specifically assigned to investigate federal drug offenses.

This affidavit is made in support of the issuance of a Criminal Complaint charging Carlos Nohe Zamudio-Beltran with violation of Title 21 U.S.C. Section 841(a)(1) and (b)(1) (A), possession with intent to distribute 1 kilogram and more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a controlled substance.

On November 17, 2010, Albuquerque Drug Enforcement Administration Agents with the assistance of Bernalillo County Sheriff's Office Deputies, served a Federal Search Warrant signed by U.S. Magistrate Judge Robert Hayes Scott at 3509 Pimlico SW, Albuquerque, NM.

Carlos Nohe Zamudio-Beltran, his wife Maria Guadalupe Reyes, and three small children all under six years of age, were all found in the master bedroom sleeping when agents entered the residence.

SA Jeff Armijo located a large sum of U.S. currency in the master bedroom closet of the residence. SA Armijo also located a large sum of U.S. currency in a dark blue Yukon Denali bearing New Mexico temporary tag D031751 with VIN# 1GKEC63898J192417, which was parked in the driveway of the residence.

Bernalillo County Sheriff's Deputy Chris Romero located a large sum of U.S. currency and approximately 3.05 gross kilograms of suspected heroin in the trunk of a dark blue Honda Accord bearing New Mexico license plate LDJ-690, which was parked in the garage of the residence.

SA Carlos Bernal-Vega as witnessed by SA Armijo, read Carlos Nohe Zamudio-Beltran his rights per *Miranda* in Spanish. Zamudio-Beltran then stated to SA Bernal-Vega that all of the money and all of the drugs found in the residence belonged to him.

SA Armijo field tested the suspected heroin and obtained a presumptive positive result for the presence of heroin
