The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about January 6, 2012, in the State and District of New Mexico, and elsewhere, defendant **RICHARD A. STACK**, did knowingly and without lawful authority produce a false identification document, that is counterfeit Federal Air Marshal identification credentials in the name of "Anthony Scott", that appeared to be issued by and under the authority of the United States Government, but was never so issued.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1028(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A)(i).

Count 2

On or about January 9, 2012, in the State and District of New Mexico, and elsewhere, defendant **RICHARD A. STACK**, did knowingly and without lawful authority produce a false identification document, that is counterfeit United States Secret Service identification credentials in the name of "Anthony Scott", that appeared to be issued by and under the authority of the United States Government, but was never so issued.

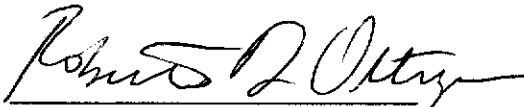
In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1028(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A)(i).

Count 3

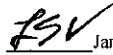
