RICHARD J. SULLIVAN, District Judge:

The Court is in receipt of the Preliminary Order of Forfeiture (Final as to the Defendant) and for Approval of Stipulation and Orders as to Defendant's Wife, Children, and Sister, dated April 21, 2010, from the government. Victims who wish to comment on these proposed orders and stipulations, particularly on the stipulation by which the government agrees to permit Defendant's wife to retain \$285,000 of the forfeited property (*see* ¶¶ 41, 49; app. 2), shall do so by making submissions to Wendy Olsen, the Victim/Witness Coordinator for the United States Attorney's Office, by May 7, 2010. Victims may do so by letter addressed to Ms. Olsen at the United States Attorney's Office, One St. Andrew's Plaza, New York, New York, 10007 or by email addressed to wendy.olsen@usdoj.gov. The government shall file all submissions with the Court, pursuant to the Crime Victims Rights Act (18 U.S.C.A. § 3771) and local rules, by May 10, 2010. The government may redact all personal data from the victims' submissions filed on ECF, but shall deliver the un-redacted submissions to the Court.
