INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about January 19, 2013, in Penndel, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JONATHAN A. MILLER, JR.

having been convicted in the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, knowingly possessed in and affecting foreign and interstate commerce a firearm and ammunition, that is, a F. LLI Pietta single action black powder .44/.45 caliber revolver, model 1858 New Army, serial number R387768, equipped with a cylinder that converts a black powder revolver to a revolver capable of discharging metallic cartridges, which was loaded with six live cartridges of Winchester .45 Colt ammunition.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

THE GRAND JURY FURTHER CHARGES THAT:

As a result of the violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1), as set forth in this indictment, defendant

JONATHAN A. MILLER, JR.


shall forfeit to the United States of America the firearm and ammunition involved in the commission of such offenses, including, but not limited to:

1. a F. LLI Pietta .44/.45 caliber revolver, model 1858 New Army, serial number R387768 equipped with a cylinder that changes it from a black powder revolver to a revolver capable of discharging metallic cartridges; and
2. six live cartridges of Winchester .45 Colt ammunition.

All pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), and Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d).
