Because your social security number was erroneously reflected on the bankruptcy petition, we are monitoring the case to ensure that a new Official Form 121 "Amended Statement About Your Social Security Number(s)" to disclose the correct social security number is filed with the Court correcting the error (see attached Form 121).

Fed. R. Bankr. P. 1009 requires that notice of amended statements must be given to the "... trustee and to any entity affected thereby." Notice of an amendment to correct the debtor's social security number must be given to all creditors. See, *In re Andrew W. Covert*, 01-10992 SBB (D. Colo. 2001). The need to directly notify parties in interest continues even under the revisions to the rules. Therefore, please immediately amend Form 121 showing the correct social security number and provide notice of this amendment to all creditors listed on the creditor matrix, the chapter 7 trustee, and this office.
